

SCHEDULING ORDER

The court having entered an Order to Show Cause on December 20, 2010, directing the six foreclosure plaintiffs identified in the order to respond to the Order to Show Cause on January 5, 2011, and appointing Edward Dauber, Esquire, Greenberg, Dauber, Epstein & Tucker, as counsel to support the proposed relief outlined in the Order to Show Cause, and requiring him to respond to the submissions of the six foreclosure plaintiffs by January 12, 2011, with replies to be filed by the foreclosure plaintiffs by January 14, 2011, and the court also having established a return date for the Order to Show Cause of January 19, 2011; and Mr. Dauber having requested an extension of the briefing schedule to permit him sufficient time to respond to the voluminous filings of the six foreclosure plaintiffs; and Mr. Dauber having proposed a schedule extending the time for all remaining submissions; and no party having filed any objection to the proposed schedule; and Mr. Dauber also having recommended to the court that the foreclosure plaintiffs participate in a settlement conference prior to the newly scheduled return date of the Order to Show Cause; and Mr. Dauber also having given his consent to the court's entry of three motions to admit counsel to appear *pro hac vice* for all matters involving the Order to Show Cause; and for good cause shown:

IT IS on this 12th day of January, 2011, **HEREBY ORDERED** that:

1. This schedule shall replace the schedule set forth in the Order to Show Cause issued on December 20, 2011.
2. Mr. Dauber's response to the filings of the six foreclosure plaintiffs shall be submitted by January 28, 2011. The response shall be filed with the Acting Clerk of the Superior Court of New Jersey, with a courtesy copy being filed directly with the chambers of Mary C. Jacobson, P.J.Ch., at 210 South Broad Street, Trenton, New Jersey 08650.
3. The replies of the six foreclosure plaintiffs to Mr. Dauber's filing shall be submitted by February 4, 2011, with filing to occur as set forth in paragraph 2.
4. The return date of the Order to Show Cause is adjourned until February 14, 2011, at 10:00 A.M.
5. A mandatory settlement conference shall be conducted at the offices of Greenberg, Dauber, Epstein & Tucker at Suite 600, One Gateway Center, Newark, New Jersey, on January 19, 2011, starting at 10:00 A.M.
6. In light of Mr. Dauber's consent to the motions filed to admit counsel *pro hac vice*, the court will issue orders granting those motions prior to the current return dates.
7. The court will provide copies of this order via facsimile to the attorneys on the attached service list and the order shall be filed in the electronic case jacket of the JEFIS system for foreclosure matters maintained by the Office of Foreclosure in the Superior Court Clerk's Office.
